PRESCHOOL

We have been super busy learning and having fun in the preschool classroom! We are moving through our Zoo Phonics alphabet. So far, we have learned letters a-r. Each week, we do activities and make crafts related to our letter of the week. Our next science lesson will involve reflections. We will be exploring different surfaces within our environment and go on a hunt for reflections. In our classroom, we put a lot of focus on social emotional skills. These skills are vital to students' success. Recently, we have been learning about identifying feelings. Children who know how to identify emotions tend to have better social skills and be less aggressive and more accepted by peers. Research shows that children who can identify their own and other people's feelings at age five are more likely than others to show academic gains by age nine.

On February 5th, our afternoon preschoolers joined the elementary students in the Global Play Day. This is an annual event promoting the importance of unstructured play in school. This year, there were 563,283 participants from 75 nations! It was fun to be a part of this awesome event. The students were put into groups with a mixture of children from preschool – 3rd graders, and traveled from classroom to classroom down our hall. Each classroom had a station. The stations included: sensory, fine motor, imagination, art, puzzles, music, building, board games and exercise. This was a time for healthy, unstructured play. As you can see in the pictures below, it was a success, and the children are already looking forward to next year's Global Play Day!
