Dear Parent/Guardian:

For your convenience we are now offering fillable vaccine forms for vaccines to be given at the school.

If you would like your child to receive a flu vaccine this year, please right click on the following link and open the hyperlink: SLVC Flu Consent: <https://pdf.ac/6lutf> or if you would like them to have a Flu Mist right click on the following link and open the hyperlink: SLVC Flu Mist Consent: <https://pdf.ac/ZNJdn> A form will have to be completed for each child needing a flu vaccine. It will ask for your name and your email. The form will automatically be sent to our office, and we will print it off there.

If you would like your child/children grades 7-12 to receive required and/or recommended vaccines (i.e. Tdap, Hep A, Gardasil, Menactra, Men B, or COVID-19 Pfizer), please right click on the following link and open the hyperlink: Multi Vaccine Consent: <https://pdf.ac/Z85r5> A form will have to be completed for each child needing a flu vaccine. It will ask for your name and your email. The form will automatically be sent to our office, and we will print it off there. Once we receive the completed forms our nurses will call you and ask you which required/recommended vaccines you would like your child to receive.

The following information is from Kansas Department of Health and Environment (KDHE): Vaccinated persons with an exposure to someone with suspected or confirmed COVID-19 are not required to quarantine if they meet all of the following criteria:

- Are fully vaccinated (i.e.,  $\geq 2$  weeks following receipt of the second dose in a 2-dose series).
- Have remained asymptomatic since the current COVID-19 exposure.

There is currently no time limit on how long fully vaccinated persons are considered immune. Persons who do not meet both above criteria will have to follow current quarantine guidelines after exposure to someone with suspected or confirmed COVID-19.
